How to add your new email account to an Android device

This document explains how to set up a connection between your Android mobile device and your new email address, so that you can use your Android device to send and receive emails.

Please Note: You will need to be connected to the internet on your device

1: Go to the "Email" app on the App Menu.



2: If you have not set up an email account on this phone before you will see the screen shown on the right. Select "Add New Account" and skip to step 3.

Username: Enter the full email address for the account you would like to add.
